

COLOR CHALLENGE BOX

Materials:

- Small cardboard box (cereal box, tissue box, etc.)
- Paint or markers/crayons/colored pencils
- Glue
- Construction paper
- Colored objects (popsicle sticks, crayons, pipe cleaners, straws, anything long and solid colored)
- Scissors or Exact-o knife



Instructions:

- 1. Take a small cardboard box and color or paint stripes of solid colors or glue construction paper color blocks on the box.
- 2. Have an adult use scissors or an Exact-o knife to cut slits in the top of the box.
- 3. Create colored popsicle sticks by coloring plain popsicle sticks or gather solid colored objects (make sure the colors match the colors on the box).
- 4. Have your child use their matching skills to match the colors of the objects to the box by sticking the colored objects in the slits.

Bonus Challenges:

- Try putting the colored objects on the wrong color block (purple object on yellow, green object on blue, etc.) and have your child unscramble them.
- Print out a picture of the color wheel and see if your child can match opposite colors based on the color wheel.
