<u>Box Habitat</u>

Materials:

- Wide variety of boxes in all sizes and shapes
- Magazines/Pictures of animals
- Child-safe scissors
- Tape or glue
- Crayons, markers, colored pencils or paint
- Any other tools you want for decorating



Instructions:

- 1. Gather a wide variety of boxes
- Have your child cut out (with parental help) a variety of animal pictures (tigers, bears, fish, etc). Be sure the animals come from different environments.
- 3. Decorate each box to fit the environments of the animals.
- 4. Practice matching skills by having your child put each animal in the box that matches it's natural environment.

Bonus fun: After you're done matching, create a box town for all the animals! Line up the different box environments in any order you like and explore. *What would your animals do if they could show each other their homes? How would the different animals come together to have a party?*
