



Treasure Box

Materials:

- ❖ Cardboard or plastic box
- ❖ Toilet paper or paper towel rolls
- ❖ Small toys/objects



Instructions:

1. Cut up the toilet paper or paper towel rolls into small pieces.
2. Spread the pieces out so the cardboard box is $\frac{3}{4}$ full of pieces.
3. Bury a few toys or objects in the pieces so they are completely hidden.
4. Have your child dig through the pieces to find the toys/objects.
5. You can repeat this activity multiple times with as many different textures in the box as you want.
6. *For more of a challenge, see what happens when you only use one texture then try mixing textures, try hiding new toys/objects each time or see if your child can tell you what each texture and objects feels like to them.*

Bonus:

If you have an older child, have them help you decorate the box like a treasure chest. You can even add objects on the outside of the box to play with and feel!
